1.10) Please highlight any specific examples of excellent teaching on this module.

- Adelina has been my favourite lecturer this year. She puts so much effort into ensuring everyone understands the content and that she is presenting information clearly. I have really enjoyed having Adelina as my lecturer this year. Seminars were recorded which was very useful for in the cases that I was unable to attend a seminar. I have had no other lecturers record the seminars and I really benefitted from Adelina doing this. Content was very clearly presented on moodle, with enough resources to prepare for the ICT. I also really appreciated Adelina putting literature resources on moodle for each topic as it showed me the sort of thing I should be including for the essay and consolidated my learning of each topic.

- I liked how the seminars were recorded as this made revision easier and being able to listen to it a few times helped me understand difficult concepts. I also really liked how there was an option to have fully remote seminars for this module. From my experience last term, hybrid seminars with in-person and remote leaders do not work as well and it's difficult to follow the class discussion remotely. The option to study remotely is very beneficial and I think it should continue to be offered even after the pandemic ends.
